**SPAIN - ANGOSTO****FROM DECEMBER 7 TO 8**

After a warm welcome they processed to the Shrine of the Virgin of Angosto to celebrate the liturgy of the Immaculate Conception. Several moments of celebration during the two days made the history of the Congregation and the Passionist charism come alive. Kissing the relic, we renewed our commitment to the future with hope. Alive and hopeful.

**SPAIN - EUBA****FROM DECEMBER 9 TO 11**

The parish of St. Paul of the Cross and the orue residence respectfully venerated the relic of St. Paul of the Cross and celebrated the Centennial with several joyful activities in the community, with the laity of the Parish and with the elderly and health professionals in the Senior Health Care Residence of Orue. **SPAIN - BILBAO****FROM DECEMBER 12 TO 15**

The church of San Felicísimo opened its doors to a joyful experience of the Jubilee and, with creativity and enthusiasm, prepared some intense days of prayer (Morning and Evening Prayer), catechesis, Masses, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Rosary. In addition, there were gatherings for the older religious in the Infirmary and a visit to the Contemplative Passionist Nuns. The presence of the Relic and the Icon have enabled a renewal of the Passionist vocation for the religious and the laity. Four religious and two postulants (pictured) spent hours making a design of a pathway with colored sand that provided access to the relic that was venerated and helped us to appreciate the life of our Founder in the Church and in the world. ### **SPAIN - LAS PRESAS**

**FROM DECEMBER 16 TO 17**

The spirituality center and the Holy Family school welcomed with devotion the signs of the Jubilee and the Relic. These were venerated with
