Holy Cross Province Summer Institute at CTU:

The CTU Summer Institute will be Monday through Friday, June 21-25, 2021 using Zoom technology. The focus will be on *A Time to See, A Time to Choose and A Time to Act*. These chapters will be discussed through the lens of our Passionist charism as shared by St. Paul of the Cross.


We continue to pray for Phillip, as he makes this further commitment to his calling from God, to be a member of our Passionist Community.
