The two exhibitions are a part of the International Theological Congress "The Wisdom of the Cross in a Pluralistic World": 21 - 24 September 2021.

The two exhibitions are an integral part of the Congress and complete its message. The Congress itself concerns the speculative study of the theological and spiritual meaning of the theme of the Wisdom of the Cross, the search for the most appropriate language.

The exhibition Gloria Passionis integrates its message with the contribution of figurative-aesthetic language that continues the tradition of the Church which has always used the figurative arts to spread the message of the Gospel. Art involves the eye, the mind, and the heart-- "beauty will save the world". However

any message is insufficient if it is not incarnated, if it is not put into practice, lived, and witnessed. This is the reason for the photographic exhibition featuring the activity of Fr. Richard Frechette, the Passionist priest and medical doctor, who for 35 years has been serving the poor, especially children, in the tormented country of Haiti, which



has been devastated by two earthquakes, hurricanes and practically has been leaderless since the assassination of the president of the Republic.

Pope Paul VI said: "Contemporary man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers; and if he listens to teachers it is because they are also witnesses". Fr. Rick is both of these figures.
