Prayer of invocation to the Holy Spirit for a Church Synod of Synodality of all Catholics, bishops, and laity alike, about governance and discornment

about governance and discernment proclaimed by Pope Francis



We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts: Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions. *Let us find in You our unity* so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.

(<u>About this prayer</u>: In the mid 1960's every session of the **Second Vatican Council** began with the prayer *Adsumus, Sancte Spiritus*, the first word of the Latin original meaning, "We stand before You, Holy Spirit," which has been historically used at Councils, Synods, and other Church gatherings for hundreds of years, being attributed to Saint Isidore of Seville [died 636].)

Dear Passionist Family,

The **Synod on Synodality** is a two-year process of listening and dialogue, starting in late 2021 and concluding with an international gathering of the Pope, some bishops and laity in late 2023 in Rome. In preparation for this, Pope Francis has invited the entire Church to reflect on the theme: *For a Synodal Church: communion, participation, and mission*. He has asked us to journey together and reflect together as one Church.



From the Preparatory Document: "This journey, which follows in the wake of the Church's 'renewal' proposed by the Second Vatican Council, is both a gift and a task: by journeying together and reflecting together on the journey that has been made, the Church will be able to learn through Her experience which processes can help Her to live communion, to achieve participation, to open Herself to mission. Our 'journeying together' is, in fact, what most effectively enacts and manifests the nature of the Church as the pilgrim and missionary People of God."

The Passion of the Earth, Wisdom of the Cross: Laudato Si' Action Platform:

The Provincial Council has committed Holy Cross Province (HCP) to engage in the *Laudato Si' Action Platform (LSAP)*. Fr. Joachim Rego, C.P., our Superior General, has already made a public commitment of our Congregation to participate in the *LSAP* and has developed a seven-year program.

The Animator will help local Passionist leaders and volunteers to bring Catholic teaching on climate change and integral ecology into their local Passionist communities.

Coming from the Charism of the Passionists, the Laudato Si' Animator will collaborate with the Provincial Superior and Council and the Laudato Si' Vision Fulfillment team (LSVFT) to promote the core of Laudato Si' and integral ecology to help turn it into action in HCP and its local communities and ministry sites, whether that be at the Provincial level, Passionist communities, parishes, schools or retreat centers.

We are grateful to Patty Gillis in her willingness to be the Animator in helping us value and protect the gift of God's creation for the future of all God's children.

Meeting of the Vowed Passionists:

Due to the current COVID situation, the planning committee of Fr. Pat Brennan, C.P.; Fr. Michael Higgins, C.P.; Fr. Jim Strommer, C.P.; and Fr.
