send me» (Is 6:8)**

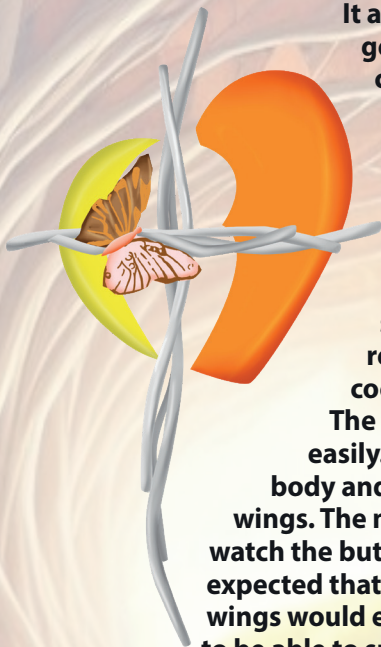


A man found a cocoon of a butterfly. One day a small opening appeared, he sat and watched the butterfly for several hours as it struggled to force its body through that little hole. Then it seemed to stop making any progress.

It appeared as if it had gotten as far as it could and it could go no farther.

Then the man decided to help the butterfly, so he took a pair of scissors and snipped off the remaining bit of the cocoon.

The butterfly emerged easily. But it had a swollen body and small, shriveled wings. The man continued to watch the butterfly because he expected that, at any moment, the wings would enlarge and expand to be able to support the body, which would contract in time.



Neither happened. In fact, the butterfly spent the rest of its life crawling around with a swollen body and shriveled wings. It was never able to fly.

What the man in his kindness and haste did not understand was that the restricting cocoon and the struggle required for the butterfly to get through the tiny opening were God's ways of forcing fluid from the body of the butterfly into its wings so that it would be ready for flight once it achieved its freedom from the cocoon. Sometimes challenges are exactly what we need in our life. If God allowed us to go through our life without any obstacles, it would cripple us. We would not be as strong as what we could have been. And we

could never fly. The Spirit, in its infinite Wisdom, offers us challenges and new opportunities to go through the unpredictable. So we can gain the strength we need to deepen into our charisma, feel the Spirit within us and fly to serve in the new ministries this suffering world requires from us.

Our prayer is that we can emerge from this Chapter stronger, confident, and full of God's love to share with others. Our prayer is that we can allow ourselves to transform like the caterpillar to a butterfly, able to fly and share God's love and grace with all.




We give you thanks, God of infinite goodness, for all of the blessings which you have showered upon our Congregation and over the greater Passionist Family.

As we approach our General Chapter, we ask that, once again, you extend your Holy Spirit over us.

Amen.

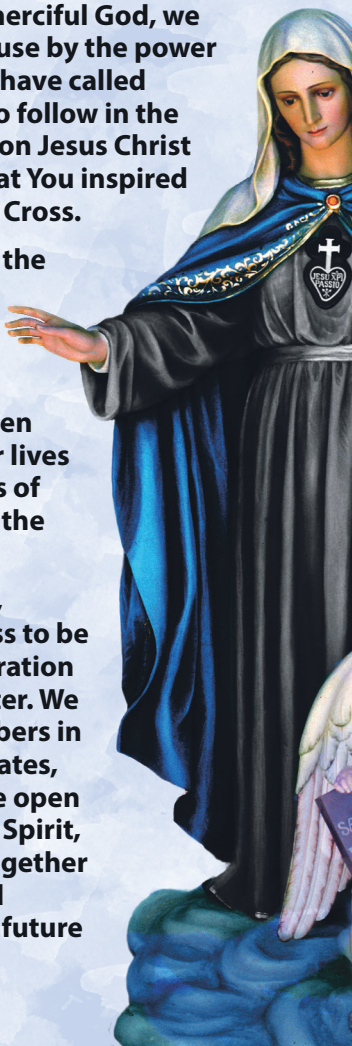
3 Hail Mary's
